Letter from Abigail Hibbard

I am involved in a Christian ministry called CRU, the U.S. ministry of Campus Crusade for Christ, at the University of Kentucky. CRU has been caring for college students since 1951. The group is very active here at UK and in over 1,000 campuses in the U.S. and overseas.

I have recently been accepted to participate in an international summer project with CRU to Central Asia for six weeks. In the country that I will be working, 68.2% of the population is unreached. These people will go their whole life without ever meeting a Christian, seeing a church, or hearing the name of Jesus Christ. The primary focus of this project will be to reach Muslim students with the Gospel through teaching English at the university's English club, building relationships with students, and also building my own relationship with God. Through this project, I will have the opportunity to spend my summer with people who have never heard the name of Jesus Christ and tell them about God's love and forgiveness.

In order to make this possible, I need to develop a team of ministry partners who will support me financially. Through your support, you will be a part of what God is doing in the world. All gifts can be made out to CRU and will be earmarked for my summer project expenses and are tax deductible. Raising the funds necessary for this project, a total of \$5,900, will be one of my greatest steps of faith in preparation for this summer.

We will hold a fundraiser lunch at Providence after worship on Sunday, April 28th. I ask that you prayerfully consider joining my team by supporting me financially. Thanks!
